“Car-free day in the Wallhalbtal in Südwestpfalz”

A fun cycle event for the whole family in the idyllic Mühlental in Wallhalben:

Sunday June 19, 2022, from 9 am until 6 pm

The beautiful scenery of the romantic Mühlental, between the mill town of Wallhalben, Landstuhl and Thaleischweiler-Fröschen, belongs exclusively to the cycling enthusiasts during this cycle event for the whole family. In the popular hiking region, once owned by bold imperial knight Franz von Sickingen, a 23-kilometers stretch through the Wallhalbtal with its 13 historic mills as far as Weihermühle via the Wasserschaupfad trail, is designated a car-free zone.

Cyclists have right of way in the Mühlental with its many shady deciduous forests between 9 am and 6 pm. Clubs set up inviting rest stops in the villages and along the cycle route. The restaurants of the historic mill houses also cater to hungry guests. Children are able to explore the local nature and enjoy various activities in both the Mühlental and the Weihermühle valley park.

A bouncy castle, pony rides and a donkey enclosure as well as a children's road track and an adventure playground await young visitors. The Wasserschaupfad, Gräfin Sonja Bernadotte Weg, Schlosswald-Weihermühle-Weg and Mühlenwanderweg trails all offer hikers opportunities to immerse themselves in the wonderful natural surrounds. The car-free Mühlental can be reached by train via Pirmasens/Nord, Thaleischweiler- Fröschen, Rieschweiler-Mühlbach and Landstuhl.
